Prayers for the Nation and People

“And seek the peace of the city where I have caused you to be carried away captive, and pray to the Lord for it; for in its peace you will have peace.” (Jer 29:7)

“Therefore I exhort first of all that supplications, prayers, intercessions, *and* giving of thanks be made for all men, for kings and all who are in authority, that we may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and reverence. For this *is* good and acceptable in the sight of God our Savior, who desires all men to be saved and to come to the knowledge of the truth.” (1 Tim 2:1-4)

These two passages tell us to pray for the nation we live in, governing leaders and all people. All the Christians are now praying for the United States. There is a bus that has signage, “Pray for America,” which will tour the continental US in 35 days encouraging everyone to pray for America. This is such an earnest plea. Our country is approaching a watershed moment, an intersection with different directions either God-centered or people-centered, and whether to walk according to the Holy Spirit or

lusts.

A psalmist said, “Blessed *is* the nation whose God *is* the Lord, The people He has chosen as His own inheritance.” (Ps 33:12)

The United States became a strong country blessed by God because it has been a God-oriented country. Even the currency includes an imprint “In God we trust” . The pledge of allegiance also includes the acknowledgement “One nation under God” . The schools used to teach students to fear and respect God. People’ s sentiment and public order were based on the foundation of fearing and respecting God. Many chapels were seen from the streets. Christian churches became a source of power for common folks and their customs.

Now, there is a breach in our country. We have to stand in the breach of the faith (Ps 106:23; Ezk 22:30). Nehemiah and Daniel prayed for their nation and people.
