The Pillar of Cloud and Fire in Our Lives

First and foremost, we can see in the Bible that the first time that the pillar of cloud and fire was mentioned in Exo 13:21-22, where it says,

“And the LORD went before them in a pillar of cloud to guide their way by day, and in a pillar of fire to give them light at night, so that they could travel by day or night.” (Exo 13:21-22)

To the Israelites, the pillar of cloud and fire (which was just essentially one pillar, not two pillars, because it was cloud by day and fire by night) led the way and acted like a compass and provided a sense of direction. Spiritually speaking, Jesus is the pillar of fire and cloud in our daily lives because He is the One who is guiding us all the time. After experiencing my first year in TTP, the main lesson that I learned is that I do not need to worry about the little or big things, but I should “look up” to Jesus for He is my guidance and strength as I walk through this spiritual wilderness of mine. If I “look back”, I will be just like Lot’s wife, who could not give up Sodom, and it is like not being able to let go of my former life, job, friends, and sinful pleasures. If I “look sideways”, I am distracted by the things of this world, such as possible comparison between me and others and what people think of me, rather than what God thinks of me. Although it makes sense to “look forward”, but spiritually, it is better to “look upward” (“the upward call of God in Christ Jesus”, Php 3:14). I may not know what the future holds (where I will live, move to, be sent, etc.), but as long as I keep my eyes on the “crown of righteousness” (2 Tim 4:8), then I will be more than fine.

Also, the pillar of cloud and fire represents God’s abidance. God was always there and **“He did not take away the pillar of cloud by day or the pillar of fire by night from before the people.”** This meant His grace was sufficient for His people. Sometimes, we go through periods of time, where it is “night”. I remember last year, there were many nights where it was hard for me to fall asleep or fall back asleep because I was missing home and family. Not only was the weather cold, but I felt cold and lonely in my heart. But I thank God that every day, during and after the two hour-long prayers, I could experience the peace and joy of God overwhelm my heart, which really showed me that I am really nothing without God. Sure, advice from members can help, but the true abidance is in God.

The pillar of cloud and fire can also represent protection in a Christian’s life. For the Israelites, who knew what lurked out at night in the wilderness. Ferocious beasts, menacing giants, and vicious enemies, what have you, were all fair game. But the Lord protected them from these perils, as we can see in Exo 14:24,

“Now it came to pass, in the morning watch, that the LORD looked down upon the army of the Egyptians through the pillar of fire and cloud, and He troubled the army of the Egyptians.” (Exo 14:24)

Our Lord God is “a wall of fire” (Zech 2:5) that protects us from sin and keeps us from harm. Whenever I am struck with

lustful thoughts, I know the surefire answer is to go to Him and cry out for I know that He will prevail, strengthen, and forgive me. (Heb 4:16) “Let us therefore come boldly to the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy and find grace to help in time of need.”

Another aspect of the pillar of cloud and fire is it is Jesus Himself in the form of the Holy Spirit and the truth. In (Jn 14:16-17), it speaks of the Holy Spirit as the Spirit of truth. In addition, in 1 Tim 3:16, a pillar is likened to “the ground of the truth”. It is true because Jesus is the way, the truth, and the life (Jn 14:6). The Holy Spirit, like the pillar of cloud and fire, guides us into the truth because it is the truth and the Spirit of Jesus (Acts 16:7). When we live by the truth, it leads us to righteousness and spiritual liberty that can only be found in Jesus. My experience in TTP thus far has been overall very sweet because I have the opportunity to study and be enveloped in the truth. The more you are surrounded by the truth, the more you want to learn more of it, and the more you are humbled by how much you do not know. It is truly a profound experience.

The pillar of cloud and fire allowed the people to walk by the truth and in today’s terms, “walk in the Spirit” (Gal 5:16, 25). Physically, the cloud can provide shade from the elements of the sun. So, by the same token, when we walk by His Spirit and truth, we will not suffer and receive shade from the scorching elements of sin. When we live by the Spirit, we will not do anything that is against the Spirit, and the spiritual battle that is within will always be won by the Spirit.

Lastly, when we follow the pillar of cloud and fire, we are learning how to submit and obey. For example, in Num 9:17-22, whenever the cloud was taken above the tabernacle, that meant the people could move, but if the cloud stayed put, the people would have to keep their tents pitched. This also meant they sometimes had to stay put for many two days, a month, or even one whole year. For these people, they did not have much, but when we look at our lives, we realize we have so many possessions. This is why it is important to live a simple life. If we have a lot of worldly cares and entanglements, it will be hard for us to move. I thank God that life for me in the last few years has become simpler. To me, all I need is my God, my family, spiritual cultivation, food, shelter, and exercise. God has taught me to live simply is a blessing. I also have learned and am continuing to learn the lesson of pure obedience. That is, wherever the church wants to send me, I will go. I also have learned that it is important to be patient and not complain because when we complain, we are complaining to God. The peace of God fills my heart so that no matter where I am being told to go, I will be at peace with it and with God. I hope I can keep learning and striving to be more humble. Amen and thank God.
