Testimony by Brother John Alexander (2)

I was determined to find out the truth for myself. I started studying and listening to sermons all the time to see if this was truly real. Slowly, but surely, my questions and doubts started getting answered. One amazing thing I thought early on about True Jesus Church was that the members welcomed my questions. They welcomed it and helped me along the way. I never felt that I just had to accept it and blindly follow what the Church said. I was able to ask questions without fear of being shut down.

In April of 2019, I received the promised Holy Spirit while I was at home. I was sick at the time. I actually had not been praying during this time because I had a sore throat. The only reason I knelt down to pray that night was because I wanted to pray for someone and the situation they were going through. All of sudden, I had this strong feeling, motivation, and my tongue started rolling. I was in disbelief. As soon as I was done praying, I called Kelly and she said it sounds like you received it! However, I was not so easily convinced. I spent the next couple of weeks doubting it and trying to see if I truly received the Holy Spirit, or if it was me rolling my tongue on my own control. But thank God, I slowly began to believe more and more and I became more filled with the Holy Spirit. I now see that God would not take control of me with His Spirit in an out-of-control way. For me, it was about letting go and letting His living water flow freely. Even with my disbelief, that very next day, I felt the strength and power of God flowing through my body to alter my life and draw closer to Him. I distinctly remember this feeling and change. This encourages me to believe that this is God's true spirit because even though I doubted, I still experienced this clear difference.

After coming to Church for a few years now, I realize how easy it is to get complacent in my faith. I see how easy it is to try and assimilate back into the world through school, work, and friends outside Church. I would like to share this realization about my life that happened recently.

I absolutely hate getting sick. There's this part of me that cares so much about productivity so when I get sick it's awful. It's actually not even so much about the symptoms of being sick, it's just that my life can't go according to what I planned that day and I can't be productive. So with that being said, I know whenever I go a few nights in a row with really limited sleep, I know I am at serious risk of getting sick. It almost happens every time.

I have always thought this was a bad thing. I always wished I wasn't like this because I can function okay without sleep, and I can muster up the energy when I am tired to focus and get things done. I can handle being tired, but I can't handle being sick.

So, last year God allowed me to understand His purpose in all of this. I realized that me getting sick from not sleeping was actually a way of God protecting me. In elementary and middle school, I would have my dad wake me up really early before school so I could get some extra studying in. I can see how I haven't changed much because I still wake up early to jumpstart the day and make it "productive." But funnily enough, I am also a person who likes to stay up late to relax after a long day. I realized that the only thing stopping me

from constantly waking up early and sleeping late to be productive was my fear of getting sick. And so, since I really don't like being sick, I realized that this is a way for God to tell me to slow down. This made me reflect on what else God is doing in other areas of my life, too, in which He was protecting me and I did not even realize it.

I think this relates to us, as well, in that we might see something the world is doing and think it is so wonderful. We may think if only I could do that, what a fun and carefree life they have, or look how much freedom they have; why this and why that? I am guilty of posing these questions to God. But in the end, I know from the Bible that this so-called,

"freedom" is a snare and burden. I am in the unique position of not growing up in True Jesus Church. So, when I have these thoughts, I simply reflect back on the memories of my past before coming to Church and remember that I was not free at all. I was a slave to the world. My eyes were set on things of this world and not on things above. I know things are not always what they appear to be because back then, my life wasn't how it appeared to be because perception can be deceiving.

I thank God for His mercy and unwavering love. May all the glory and praise be unto His holy name. Amen.
