NATS Rules and Regulations

- 1. Participants must attend all classes. If you must be absent for any reason, please inform the coordinators and obtain their consent. If you must go out, please fill out the Leave Request Form in advance and ask the coordinators to agree. If you are absent from classes for more than one day, you will not be counted as a full-time participant.
- 2. Participants who stay outside the church must attend morning Bible study on time and leave after evening prayer. (Participants will be counted as absent if you arrive late or leave early. If you are absent for more than one day, you will not be counted as a full-time participant).
- 3. If you need to purchase anything that is urgent, please fill out the purchase request form and please pay for it.
- 4. Be punctual to every class. Please proceed to class once the bell rings. Respect the lecturers in class; do not speak and walk around. Refrain from eating and drinking in the chapel. Do not bring food into the chapel.
- 5. Please set your phone to silent mode. The use of mobile phones and tablets during class time is limited to reading the Bible, singing hymns and taking class notes. If you need to use your mobile phone, you can use it sparingly during lunch, dinner or snack time. Surfing the unnecessary websites on your device should be avoided.
- 6. Check all schedules daily, and faithfully perform the duties you have been assigned. Work together as a team. Team captains are to ensure that their team completes the cleaning tasks assigned to them.
- 7. Room captains are to maintain quietness, cleanliness and order in the bedrooms. Lead room members to pray together before 10:55 p.m. All lights should be out at 11 p.m.
- 8. Keep quiet after lights out and before 7 a.m. Please walk quietly and shut the door lightly.
- 9. A shower sign-up sheet will be posted outside the bathroom daily. Please honor everyone's shower time. Do not take the slot of others.
- 10. Participants can only take photos within the specified time.
- 11. Dress should be appropriate and neat. Wear your nametag at all times.
- 12. Please separate the plates, bowls, and utensils according to the labeled boxes after meals.
